## Council President's 2022 Annual Letter

Dear Members and Friends of St. Paul UCC,

As we begin 2023 and reflect on 2022, there is much we can celebrate. The most important achievement was the calling of Dennis Landaw as our pastor. After more than a year of diligent work by the search committee, through a pandemic, Pastor Landaw began his call in July. I'd like to thank Susan Whitmore and the search committee for all their selfless work to find our new pastor.

Pastor Landaw has assumed his call with unmatched enthusiasm. He has "jumped in armpit deep" so to speak. He is an active member of the Fairless Clergy Association, and has developed great working relationships with many of his local colleagues. He is working to provide our church with representation and collaboration with the Living Water Association as well as tapping into the resources of the association. He has worked to have the Blessing Box installed in front of Parish Hall to help with food insecurity in our community. Pastor Landaw has met with all the church committees and is participating in the visioning of each committee.

Pastor Landaw and his wife, Nadine, have been a true blessing to our church since their arrival. In my view, it is ideal that they have moved into the parsonage. In anticipation of their move, our church made several upgrades in the parsonage. This included the remodeling of the kitchen, removal of wallpaper, and painting. Many thanks to Tim Alter, Mike Kuhn, the trustees and many others who assisted and donated to make these improvements possible.

Another achievement this year was the installation of a new sound system funded by the memorial committee. In addition to improved

sound, the digital platform provides much better control both in the sanctuary and for the streaming service. Many thanks to Randy Yoder for spearheading this installation and implementation.

In an effort to coordinate St. Paul's impact from a local, regional, national and international perspective, Julie Feucht has agreed to chair the new mission committee. This committee will be tasked with identifying and vetting various causes for our church to support. Similar to our support of Ukraine refugees last year, I feel it is important that our members know, understand and are provided updates on the causes we support.

Unlike many churches, St. Paul has weathered the COVID-19 lockdowns and emerged on pretty good footing. Our attendance continues to improve, our giving is consistent, and we've added new members. The committee purchased a new sound system and it was recently installed. They are still working out a few final adjustments to the system. We are hoping to have the sound system dedicated in the first quarter of 2023. The system was purchased with memorial funds in memory of Doris Wentling, Janet Baker, Gloria Krichbaum, Cleo Kilgore, Doris and Bill Whitmore, Grace Oakleaf, Jim Arthur, Jo Ann Golden, Richard Pickens, Cleo Allen, Zola Smeyres, Linda Haas, Tim Bryan, and Ruth Moulos.

The total estimated cost of the sound system was \$8,350.00. We paid an initial payment of \$4,000.00 before the installation and are still waiting to make the final payment once everything meets our approval.

The committee is also checking into a new sign to replace the temporary yellow sign in the front yard of the church. This will be an ongoing project for 2023.

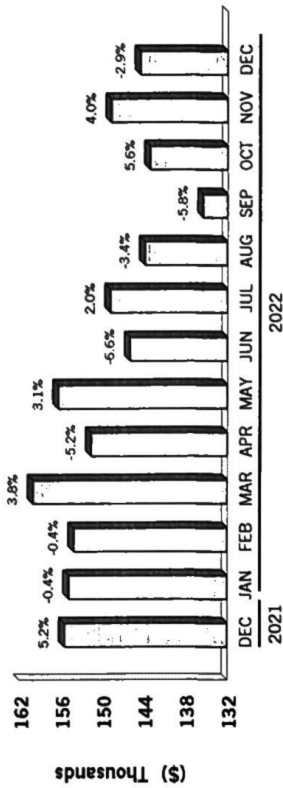

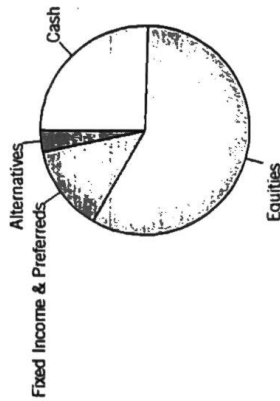
